Proclamation

WHEREAS, the 35 public transit systems – urban, rural and tribal - in Oklahoma provide over 9 million trips in Oklahoma every year; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Transit Association is participating in the American Public Transportation Association first ever ‘Stand Up for Transportation Day’ highlighting the value of all Oklahoma transportation infrastructure;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim April 9, 2015, as
