

Proclamation

WHEREAS, "Speak Out for Workplace Safety!" is a statewide video contest created by the Oklahoma Department of Labor in partnership with the Oklahoma Safety Council, to help middle and high school students obtain the skills they need to stay safe and healthy in the workplace for the rest of their lives; and

WHEREAS, this endeavor enabled government administrators, school officials, industry leaders, and community advocates to work together to improve young worker safety awareness throughout Oklahoma's seventy-seven counties; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education and the Oklahoma Department of Labor promoted the video contest and invited students in grades 9 – 12 to produce a workplace safety PSA based on concepts learned from the NIOSH Youth@Work Talking Safety OSH curriculum; and

WHEREAS, DUIT Holdings Inc., Oklahoma One Call System Inc., JE Dunn Construction, and Association of Oklahoma General Contractors made the contest possible with their generous prize sponsorships; and

WHEREAS, the prizewinning videos, produced by teens to teach their peers about workplace safety, were honored at the Oklahoma State Capitol; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARY FALLIN, GOVERNOR, do hereby proclaim the week of April 13 – 17, 2015, as

"Speak Out for Workplace Safety Week!"
