Proclamation

Whereas, the State of Oklahoma recognizes the importance of auditing by acknowledging the value of a systematic, disciplined approach to evaluating and improving the effectiveness of risk management, internal control, governance, information technology, education and security processes; and

Whereas, because internal auditing is increasingly sophisticated and complex and requires specialized knowledge training, the Oklahoma City and Tulsa Chapters of the Institute of Internal Auditors (IIA) provide continuing professional education activities and guidance regarding internal auditing and its appropriate role in protecting against risks, balancing opportunities and vulnerabilities, and assessing and strengthening corporate governance to various industries in our great state; and

Whereas, internal auditors are committed to fulfilling the mission of our founders to provide a wide range of opportunities for professional development and communication and adding value to our members, member organizations, and our profession; and

Whereas, the national IIA, the Oklahoma City Chapter, and the Tulsa Chapter includes working together to promote an advocacy strategy by building relationships with governments entities, regulators, oversight bodies, and professional associates whose decisions often impact internal auditors;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim the month of May 2015 as
