

Proclamation

Whereas, during difficult economic times, inability to pay an energy bill can cause serious hardships to a family facing a financial emergency; and

Whereas, Public Service Company of Oklahoma, Oklahoma Gas & Electric Company and Oklahoma Natural Gas Company have each created a fuel fund, whereby customers can make donations for less fortunate Oklahomans; and

Whereas, the names of the fuel funds are Light-A-Life, Lend-A-Hand, and Share the Warmth, respectively; and

Whereas, each utility company has joined with The Salvation Army to administer the funds, and

Whereas, contributions to the fuel funds amounted to \$417,798.05 for 2014 and assisted 4,457 families, consisting of 11,536 Oklahomans; and

Whereas, the state of Oklahoma recognizes and appreciates the thousands of utility customers who contribute to the fuel funds, the utility companies that make significant contributions and who help provide a convenient method for customers to contribute, The Oklahoma Masons for their support, and The Salvation Army who administers the program; and

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim the month of July 2015 as

“Home Energy Aid Month”

in the state of Oklahoma and encourage the participation of our citizens in supporting this Oklahoma energy assistance event.
