

Proclamation

Whereas, occurring in as many as 1 in 3000 births, Arthrogryposis is a neuro-musculo-skeletal disorder that adversely affects multiple joints in the body; and

Whereas, the medical terminology for the disorder is Arthrogryposis Multiplex Congenita (AMC); and

Whereas, joints of an AMC patient show contractures, stiffness, poor mobility or immobility and muscle fatigue; and

Whereas, joints affected by AMC may include hands, feet, hips, knees, elbows, shoulders, wrists, fingers, toes, jaw, and spine; no two people are affected exactly the same way; and

Whereas, effective management of Arthrogryposis requires a multi-disciplinary approach, with treatment plans including surgical intervention, physiotherapy and occupational therapy, and a goal of promoting independence and improving the quality of life;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim June 30, 2015, as

“Arthrogryposis Awareness Day”

in the state of Oklahoma.
