

Proclamation

Whereas, the group, "Peruanosenoklahoma," will honor this friendship by celebrating the Peruvian Festival 2015 in Oklahoma City;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim July 28th, 2015, as
