Proclamation

Whereas, Oklahoma law prohibits the sale of tobacco products to anyone under the age of 18; and

Whereas, *We Card* Awareness Month is a retail education and training program designed to improve Oklahoma retailers' awareness and boost their participation in efforts to responsibly comply with all applicable laws in order to prevent tobacco and other age-restricted product sales to minors; and

Whereas, 2015 marks the 20th anniversary of the national non-profit organization, the *We Card* Program, Inc.;

Whereas, Oklahomans benefit from a conscientious retailing community that successfully keeps tobacco and other age-restricted products out of the hands of minors.

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim the month of September 2015 as

"We Card Awareness Month"

in Oklahoma, and encourage retailers in our state to let their customers know they don't sell tobacco and other age-restricted products to kids.
