

Proclamation

Whereas, the Tribal Film Festival was born out of the necessity for stories of indigenous people to be seen, heard and preserved on a broad scale with an emphasis on inspirational and stirring movies; and

Whereas, indigenous films will be presented at the Dream Theatre, in Tahlequah, during the three day Festival for the entertainment of an expected one hundred thousand people in genres that include family entertainment, comedy, historical, and mystery; and

Whereas, citizens of Oklahoma acknowledge the rich, deep culture and customs passed down through the stories of indigenous people; and

Whereas, indigenous culture has permeated the lives of Oklahomans significantly to the advancement of our state;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim September 4th through September 6th, 2015, as

“Tribal Film Festival Days”

in the state of Oklahoma.
