

Proclamation

Whereas, over the years, student-related housing fires have tragically cut short the lives of some of our nation's young people; and

Whereas, automatic fire alarm systems and smoke alarms provide the necessary early warning of a house fire to occupants and their local fire department; and

Whereas, automatic fire sprinkler systems are a highly effective method of controlling or extinguishing a fire in its early stages and protecting the lives of the building's occupants; and

Whereas, educational programs should be provided to students during September and throughout the school year; and


Whereas, it is fitting and proper to encourage campus officials and others to evaluate the level of fire safety being provided in both on- and off- campus student housing and take the necessary steps to ensure fire-safe living environments through fire safety education, installation of fire suppression and detection systems and smoke alarms, and the development and enforcement of applicable codes relating to fire safety;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim September 2015 as

"Campus Fire Safety Month"
