

Proclamation

Whereas, Promociones Guatemala en Oklahoma was created to promote better understanding of the Guatemalan culture and tradition in the state of Oklahoma; and

Whereas, Guatemalan Independence Day will be observed on September 15, 2015, to celebrate the freedom and history of the people of Guatemala; and

Whereas, the observance of Guatemalan Independence Day will emphasize to all Oklahomans the great and significant contributions Guatemalans have made to the progress of our state; and

Whereas, the observance of Guatemalan Independence Day will keep Guatemalan traditions alive among the younger generations of Guatemalans born and brought up in Oklahoma;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim Tuesday, September 15, 2015, as

“Guatemalan Independence Day”

in the state of Oklahoma
