

Proclamation

Whereas, Longhorn Cattle represent ranching, the cowboy and the American pioneer; and

Whereas, in 1964, the Texas Longhorn Breeders Association of American (TLBAA) began in Lawton, Oklahoma, and continued to be an integral part of the Chisholm Trail; and

Whereas, The Texas Longhorn Breeders Association of America is a non-profit organization working to preserve the legacy and distinctive characteristics of Texas Longhorns while ensuring pureness and posterity; and

Whereas, the TLBAA's 2015 Horn Showcase will be held at the Great Plains Coliseum in Lawton, Oklahoma, with more than 500 spectators and participants from across the United States and Canada;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim October 1 through October 3, 2015, as

"Horn Showcase Days"

in the state of Oklahoma.
