

Proclamation

Whereas, studies show children who exercise on a regular basis perform higher academically at the elementary and middle school levels because they are keener, less tired, and in better control of their aggression; and

Whereas, Project Fit America (PFA) is a non-profit organization, now in three hundred cities in forty-six states, whose mission is to establish exemplary Fitness In Education in schools to get children physically fit and empower them to take care of their health; and

Whereas, PFA creates excellent academic programs that provide equipment, curriculum instruction, on-site teacher training and measurable outcomes, as well as rewards and incentives for all participating students; and

Whereas, on September 29, 2015, Jane Phillips Medical Center and Truity Credit Union will launch PFA at Wayside Elementary School in Bartlesville, Oklahoma; and

Whereas, Wayside Elementary School along with teachers, parents and countless community members are participating in a school fitness initiative to aid in making Washington County children healthier and more physically active;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim September 29, 2015, as
