

**Whereas**, Taiwan is ranked as the United States' tenth largest trading partner and bilateral trade between our two countries reached \$67.4 billion in 2014; and

**Whereas**, cities within the state of Oklahoma have sister city relationships with Taipei, Tainan and Kaohsiung, and an excellent working relationship with the Taipei Economic and Cultural Office in Houston to actively support and encourage cultural, educational and business exchanges; and

**Whereas**, our citizens and business community look forward to many years of continued cooperation between the state of Oklahoma and Taiwan;

**Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor**, do hereby proclaim October 10<sup>th</sup>, 2015, as
