

Whereas, on October 13, 1775, the United States Navy was established by our nation's leaders; and

Whereas, the United States Navy will be celebrating its two hundred and fortieth birthday during the month of October 2015; and

Whereas, for many decades Oklahomans have proudly served in the United States Navy and Navy Reserve throughout the world;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim the month of October 2015 as

"United States Navy Month"

in the state of Oklahoma and urge our citizens to honor the strength, professionalism and bravery of our resilient sailors.
