

Proclamation

Whereas, family and consumer sciences professionals and associations across our great state work to strengthen the welfare of all Oklahomans through public policy, professional development, outreach and research; and

Whereas, the study of family and consumer sciences assists youth and adults in making sound choices that result in healthy, productive and fulfilling lives;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim December 3, 2015, as

“Family and Consumer Sciences Day”

in the state of Oklahoma.
