

**Whereas**, the Oklahoma City branch works with educators, students and the general public to promote economic and financial education and greater knowledge of the Federal Reserve; and


**Whereas**, the Oklahoma City branch supports community economic growth through research and resources for bankers, economic developers, and small business owners;
