

Whereas, January 28, 2016, marks the first anniversary of the Youth Trumpet & Taps Corps Association being established as a non-profit organization in the state of Oklahoma; and

Whereas, the Youth Trumpet & Taps Corps is recognized as a 501(c)(3) non-profit and has expanded to include students in six states around the nation; and

Whereas, due to an insufficient number of military buglers, many service men and women receive only an audio recording of Taps when they are laid to rest; and

Whereas, Youth Trumpet & Taps Corps projects include service activities such as playing Taps at military funerals and performing patriotic music at community events; and

Whereas, the Youth Trumpet & Taps Corps provides high school trumpet players the unique opportunity to use their musical gifts to honor those who have previously served our country with valor; and

Whereas, it is fitting and proper to recognize our high school students for their patriotism and volunteerism;


Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim January 28, 2016, as
