

Proclamation

Whereas, motorcycles are a popular means of transportation for commuting, touring and recreation in Oklahoma and across the nation; and

Whereas, the safe operation of a motorcycle requires a combination of rider training, experience, good judgment, and knowledge of traffic laws and licensing requirements; and


Whereas, due to the increasing number of motorcyclists on the road, it is appropriate to set aside time to promote motorcycle safety awareness;
