

## Proclamation

**Whereas**, it is proper that Oklahomans commemorate the vision and resolution displayed by pioneer men and women who opened our territory to settlement on April 22, 1889; and

**Whereas**, Oklahoma's land run marked the beginning of the most dramatic and colorful period of history in our great state; and

**Whereas**, it is appropriate to reflect on the brave deeds, determination and faith that guided those early settlers as they built a firm foundation for future Oklahomans; and

**Whereas**, the Oklahoma Legislature has declared the historic city of Guthrie, in Logan county, shall be the official city of festivity for '89ers Week; and

**Whereas**, events taking place throughout the week in Guthrie include a parade, carnival, baseball game, as well as concerts, contests, and dances;

**Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor**, do hereby proclaim the week of April 19<sup>th</sup>, 2016, as
