

Proclamation

Whereas, Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR), founded in 1890 and headquartered in Washington, D.C., is a nonprofit, nonpolitical volunteer women's service organization dedicated to promoting patriotism, preserving American history, and securing America's future through better education for children; and

Whereas, its timeless principles of character and patriotism continue to keep DAR strong and vitally relevant in our ever-changing world; and

Whereas, Oklahomans are urged to acknowledge the more than 3000 members of the Oklahoma Society Daughters of the American Revolution who performed 64,442 hours of volunteer service in their communities in 2015 and their dedication supporting active duty military personnel and assisting veteran patients, as well as awarding thousands of dollars in scholarships and financial aid each year to underserved students;

Now, Therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim April 14th through April 16th, 2016, as
