

Proclamation

Whereas, the Oklahoma Educational Television Authority (OETA) was created in 1953, when Governor Johnston Murray signed House Bill 1033 into law, making Oklahoma the first state to provide for a statewide educational television service; and

Whereas, the network, which began in the basement of University of Oklahoma classroom building, has spread its signal across our state, developing into a major source of education, culture and entertainment; and

Whereas, OETA has a deep impact across Oklahoma through its educational outreach and television programming; and

Whereas, OETA produces local programming for a statewide audience and has won numerous local, state, regional and national awards for its news, public affairs, documentary, history and arts and culture programs; and

Whereas, OETA is America's most watched Public Broadcasting Service network and continues to utilize its statewide reach, content development and educational outreach services to build stronger communities;

Now, Therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim April 20, 2016, as

"OETA Diamond Anniversary Day"

in the state of Oklahoma.
