

# Proclamation

**Whereas**, Oklahoma's public works professionals, engineers and administrators should be recognized for their dedication and contributions to the growth, development and stability of our state;

**Whereas**, 2016 marks the 56<sup>th</sup> annual National Public Works Week sponsored by the American Public Works Association;

**Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor**, do hereby designate the week May 15-21, 2016, as
