

Proclamation

Whereas, X & Y chromosome variations are common, frequently undiagnosed genetic conditions that can differ from the normal sex chromosome pairings of XX for females and XY for males; and

Whereas, 1 in 500 children in the United States have X & Y chromosome variations that cause complex learning disabilities, including language impairment, motor planning deficits, reading dysfunction, and attention and behavioral disorders; and

Whereas, greater awareness regarding X & Y chromosome variations are necessary to encourage those stricken with the condition to reach their greatest potential through accurate and early diagnosis combined with appropriate education, support, and intervention, all of which are essential to future growth and development;

Now, Therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim May 2016 as

"X & Y Chromosome Variations Awareness Month"

in the state of Oklahoma
