

Proclamation

Whereas, Head Start has functioned as an anti-poverty program for over 50 years; and

Whereas, Head Start provides a comprehensive program of health, early childhood education, parent engagement, family and parenting education and services for children with disabilities, all of which are coordinated through Community Action agencies, private nonprofit organizations, American Indian Tribes, and local school districts; and

Whereas, Sapulpa opened its first Head Start programs at Calvary Baptist Church and Mt. Olive Baptist Church in June 1966; and

Whereas, Sapulpa's Head Start services are largely effective due to the active involvement of parents, volunteers and the community; and

Whereas, services provided by dedicated Sapulpa Head Start staff have been instrumental in creating a quality program that truly provides young children with a "head start" in life;

Now, Therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim May 12, 2016, as

"Sapulpa Head Start 50th Anniversary Day"

in the state of Oklahoma.
