

Proclamation

Whereas, Syringomyelia is a chronic disorder causing cysts to form inside the spinal cord; and

Whereas, Syringomyelia occurs when cerebrospinal fluid (normally found outside of the spinal cord and brain) enters the interior of the spinal cord, forming a cavity known as a syrinx; and

Whereas, the American Syringomyelia and Chiari Alliance Project (ASAP) is a nonprofit organization that provides support, funds research, educates the public, and strives to bring hope to those affected with this disease; and

Whereas, Syringomyelia Malformation Awareness Month is an opportunity to spread mindfulness and understanding regarding this chronic disease in order for critical research to continue and subsequently improve the quality of life for those with Syringomyelia;

Now, Therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim May 2016 as

"Syringomyelia Malformation Awareness Month"

in the state of Oklahoma.


