

Proclamation

Whereas, every year too many Oklahoma families face the stark terror of a missing loved one; and

Whereas, more than 1,040 Oklahomans have been listed as missing and 117 unidentified souls entered into the Justice Department's National Missing and Unidentified Persons System also known as NamUs; and

Whereas, the disappearance of a child strikes an incalculable blow against the spirit of any family so afflicted; and

Whereas, upon realizing a missing person cannot be located, there is an insurmountable sense of fear and uncertainty regarding the circumstances of the disappearance; and


Whereas, keeping the focus on missing persons cases is a priority for law enforcement and for the community, as we direct our resources to the worthy goal of locating missing loved ones;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim June 11, 2016, as

"Missing Persons Day"

in the state of Oklahoma.
