

Whereas, prevention of this disease is paramount, and early diagnosis and intervention are crucial, and correct aggressive treatment by qualified medical professionals can lead to positive results;

Now, Therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim July 2016 as

"Arachnoiditis Awareness Month"

in the state of Oklahoma.
