

Proclamation

Whereas, appropriate irrigation technology, combined with best practices, can significantly improve residential and commercial water-use efficiency; and

Whereas, the Oklahoma Nursery and Landscape Association and the Oklahoma Irrigation Association collaborate to protect this critical natural resource by emphasizing advances in irrigation technology and the importance of proper water usage that can benefit efficiency in agricultural, residential and commercial activities;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim the month of July 2016 as

“Smart Irrigation Month”

in the state of Oklahoma.
