Whereas, mobilized through the Oklahoma Blood Institute and the American Red Cross, public awareness has resulted in more efficient collection of blood and increased voluntary blood donors; and

Whereas, Oklahoma Blood Donation Day serves to remind the public to replenish blood supplies through donation; and

Now, Therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim September 10, 2016,
as

"Blood Donation Day"
