

Proclamation

Whereas, the Tribal Film Festival was born out of the necessity for stories of indigenous people to be seen, heard and preserved on a broad scale with an emphasis on inspirational and stirring movies; and

Whereas, during the three-day festival, indigenous films will be presented at the Dream Theatre in Tahlequah; and

Whereas, the festival will include films from many genres that highlight the rich, deep culture and customs passed down through the stories of indigenous people; and

Whereas, indigenous culture has permeated Oklahoma, significantly advancing of our state;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim September 2 through September 4, 2016, as

"Tribal Film Festival Days"

in the state of Oklahoma.
