

Proclamation

Whereas, vision problems are a noteworthy issue among children and can affect their academic performance; and

Whereas, nearly one-half of possibly blinding conditions can be prevented and treated through early detection; and

Whereas, as children in Oklahoma start of another school year, many will begin their studies with undiagnosed or untreated vision problems; and

Whereas, public awareness about learning-related vision problems is necessary to ensure that children receive the prompt vision treatment they need to enhance their lives and learning experiences;

Now, Therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim August 2016, as

"Children's Vision and Learning Month"

in the state of Oklahoma.
