

Whereas, Guatemalan Independence Day will be observed on September 15, 2016, to celebrate the 195th anniversary of that country's independence; and

Whereas, Oklahomans recognize the importance of friendship and increasing public awareness of the cultural and commercial relationship between our state and the Republic of Guatemala; and

Whereas, the observance of Guatemalan Independence Day helps keep traditions alive among the younger generations of Oklahomans of Guatemalan descent;

Now, Therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim September 15, 2016, as
