

Proclamation

Whereas, prostate cancer is the most common form and the second leading cause of cancer-related deaths in American men; and

Whereas, more than 180,000 new cases of prostate cancer will be diagnosed this year; and

Whereas, African-American men, men with a family history of prostate cancer and men exposed to Agent Orange are at the highest risk; and

Whereas, prostate cancer is usually treatable, if detected early; and

Whereas, early stage prostate cancer usually has no symptoms; and

Whereas, men who are educated about the value of early detection will be more likely to have the cancer detected when it is treatable; and

Whereas, male Oklahomans are encouraged to discuss prostate cancer with their healthcare provider, increase understanding of their risk, and learn about available screening options;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim September 2016 as

"Prostate Cancer Awareness Month"

in the state of Oklahoma.
