

Proclamation

Whereas, truck driving jobs have expanded 18.8 percent since 2010; and

Whereas, professional truck drivers have been honored for being among the safest drivers on our highways and have been recognized for acts of bravery such as saving motorists from injury or death; and

Whereas, America's professional truck drivers are hard-working men and women who serve their communities, schools and businesses with dedication and without fanfare every day; and


Whereas, our economic system rides on the wheels of trucks and on the shoulders of the people who safely drive those trucks;
