

Proclamation

Whereas, each year, cancer is detected in nearly 15,000 of our nation's young people; and

Whereas, one in five children diagnosed with cancer in the United States will die; and

Whereas, due advancements in medical treatments, mortality rates have declined; however, cancer is still the leading cause of death by disease among American children; and

Whereas, much of what the medical community knows about treating adult cancer has been learned from childhood cancer research; and

Whereas, Oklahoma organizations, advocates and hospitals work to increase awareness of the signs of childhood cancer, promote active cancer screening tests and treatments and support families affected by childhood cancer; and

Whereas, the fortitude and bravery with which these children fight their battles against cancer should be recognized and commended by all;

Now, Therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim September 2016 as

"Childhood Cancer Awareness Month"

in the state of Oklahoma.
