## Proclamation

**Whereas**, Oklahoma's 66 credit unions are proudly among the 6,078 state and federally chartered credit unions nationwide; and

**Whereas**, these consumer-owned, not-for-profit, democratically controlled financial institutions, were founded by people working together toward mutual economic advancement; and

**Whereas**, Oklahoma's credit unions are an important economic force, employing approximately 3,300 people and serving more than 1.2 million customers; and

**Whereas**, the influence of credit unions on our financial system saves consumers money through lower rates for loans and higher rates for savings, no matter where they conduct their financial business; and

**Whereas**, Oklahoma recognizes the importance of credit unions and the positive impact they have in our communities;

**Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor**, do hereby proclaim October 20, 2016, as

### "Credit Union Day"

in the state of Oklahoma.
