Whereas, dystonia is commonly misdiagnosed, delaying access to appropriate medical care; and

Whereas, there are limited treatments for dystonia and currently no cure; and

Whereas, often friends, families and caregivers must shoulder the physical, emotional and financial burdens of dystonia; and

Whereas, the severity of the symptoms and numerous manifestations of dystonia as well as the limited public awareness of the disease cause many patients to experience isolation; and


Whereas, the dystonia community is uniting in September to increase awareness of this debilitating disorder;
