

Proclamation

Whereas, Oklahoma City has reveled in the beauty and sophistication of the Skirvin Hotel since its grand opening in 1911; and

Whereas, the famous Skirvin building was architecturally restored in 2007 to ensure it remains a historically significant landmark in the Oklahoma City landscape; and

Whereas, the Skirvin Hilton Hotel boasts 225 luxuriously appointed guest rooms and suites, 18,500 square feet of meeting space, two ballrooms, three world-class board room rentals, three sumptuous event rooms, and a pre-function lounge room; and

Whereas, the Skirvin Hilton Hotel has undergone multi-million dollar renovations recently, modernizing its renowned Red Piano Lounge, guest rooms and lobby area; and

Whereas, it is fitting to congratulate the Skirvin Hilton Hotel on its ribbon cutting and acknowledge the hotel as one of Oklahoma's most iconic fixtures;

Now, Therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim October 25, 2016, as
