A JOINT RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO REFER TO THE PEOPLE FOR THEIR APPROVAL OR REJECTION, A PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO SECTION 3 OF ARTICLE 6, OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE SEVENTEENTH LEGISLATURE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. Proposed Amendment. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by the law, the following proposed amendment to Section 3, Article 6, of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

"Section 3. No person shall be eligible to the office of Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, State Auditor, Attorney General, State Treasurer, Superintendent of Public Instruction or State Examiner and Inspector, except a citizen of the United States of the age of not less than thirty-one (31) years and who shall have been ten (10) years next preceding his or her election, a qualified elector of this State."

SECTION 2. Ballot Title. The ballot title for said proposed amendment shall be in the following form:

"Ballot Title"

The gist of the proposed amendment is: "That Section 3, Article 6, of the Constitution of Oklahoma be amended to read as follows:

"No person shall be eligible to the office of Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, State Auditor, Attorney General, State Treasurer, Superintendent of Public Instruction, State Examiner and Inspector, except a citizen of the United States of the age of not less than thirty-one years and who shall have been ten years next preceding his or her election, a qualified elector of this State."
