

You are hereby notified that, pursuant to the discretion and duty lodged in and imposed upon the Attorney General by 34 O.S. Supp. 1976, §9, he has examined the proposed ballot title to Enrolled Senate Joint Resolution No. 20 of the First Regular Session of the Thirty-sixth Oklahoma Legislature, and from said examination finds that said ballot title is not in legal form and harmony with the law. Therefore, the Attorney General submits the following ballot title which, in his opinion, is in legal form and in harmony with the law.

State Question No. 527 Legislative Referendum No. 221

THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

Shall a constitutional amendment

repealing Section 11 of Article XXIII of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma which defines the words, "colored" or "colored race", "negro" or "negro race", and "white race"

be approved by the people?
