**"WARNING"**

It is a felony for anyone to sign an initiative or referendum petition with any name other than his own, or knowingly to sign his name more than once for the measure, or to sign such petition when he is not a legal voter.

**INITIATIVE PETITION**

TO THE HONORABLE GEORGE NIGH  
GOVERNOR OF OKLAHOMA:

We, the undersigned citizens and legal voters of the State of Oklahoma, respectfully order that the following proposed law shall be submitted to the legal voters of the State of Oklahoma for their approval or rejection at the regular general election, to be held on the 2nd day of November, 1982, but much more preferably at a special election which might be called for said purpose after filing of this petition, and each for himself says:

"I have personally signed this petition; I am a legal voter of the State of Oklahoma; my residence and post office are correctly written after my name. The time for filing this petition expires ninety days from August 31, 1981. The question we herewith submit to our fellow voters is: Shall the following proposed Statute be approved?"

**TITLE**

AN ACT RELATING TO CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS: REPEALING SECTION 1, CHAPTER 210, O.S.L. 1972 (14 O.S. SUPP 1980 SECTION 4) AND SENATE BILL 356, OF THE FIRST SESSION OF THE 38TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE WHICH RELATES TO CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS: FIXING BOUNDARIES AND DIVIDING THE STATE INTO SIX CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS: PROVIDING THAT THIS ACT SHALL NOT AFFECT THE OPERATION OF ANY BOARD, COMMISSION OR OTHER ENTITY WHOSE MEMBERSHIP IS BASED UPON CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS WHICH HAVE HERETOFORE BEEN CREATED BY LAW: PROVIDING FOR CORRECTION OF SCRIVENER'S ERRORS: PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATE: DIRECTING THE STATE ELECTION BOARD TO COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT: PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA.

SECTION 1. Section 1, Chapter 210, O.S.L. 1972 (14 O.S. Supp 1980, Section 4) and Senate Bill 356, of the First Session of the 38th Oklahoma Legislature are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. The State of Oklahoma is hereby divided into six (6) Congressional Districts hereinafter described, based on the Federal Decennial Census of 1980:
