A JOINT RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO REFER TO THE PEOPLE FOR THEIR APPROVAL OR REJECTION A PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO SECTIONS 1 AND 4 OF ARTICLE VI OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA; PROVIDING FOR THE ELECTION OF THE COMMISSIONER OF LABOR; PROVIDING FOR TERM OF SUCH OFFICER; PROVIDING BALLOT TITLE; AND DIRECTING FILING.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 41ST OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, the following proposed amendments to Sections 1 and 4 of Article VI of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:

Section 1. A. The Executive authority of the state shall be vested in a Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, State Auditor and Inspector, Attorney General, State Treasurer, Superintendent of Public Instruction, Commissioner of Labor, Commissioner of Insurance and other officers provided by law and this Constitution, each of whom shall keep his office and public records, books and papers at the seat of government, and shall perform such duties as may be designated in this Constitution or prescribed by law.

B. The Secretary of State ~~and the Commissioner of Labor~~ shall be appointed by the Governor by and with the consent of the Senate for terms a term of four (4) years to run concurrently with the term of the Governor.
