We the undersigned legal voters of the State of Oklahoma respectfully order that the following proposed Amendment to The Constitution of the State of Oklahoma shall be submitted to the legal voters of the State of Oklahoma for their approval or rejection at the next regular general election (or at a special election as may be called by the Governor), and each for himself/herself says I have personally signed this petition; I am a legal voter of the State of Oklahoma; my residence is correctly written after my name. The time for filing this petition expires ninety (90) days from _____ . The question we herewith submit to our fellow voters is:

Shall the following proposed new Article 32 to The Constitution of the State of Oklahoma be approved?

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF OKLAHOMA THAT A NEW ARTICLE 32 TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA BE APPROVED.

As per Article 31 of the Oklahoma State Constitution, Adult Use of marijuana shall be legal for persons eighteen (18) years of age and older to purchase from a legally licensed adult-use dispensary, to possess, and to consume marijuana and marijuana products.

As per Article 31 of the Oklahoma State Constitution and Oklahoma State Question 788, Medical Marijuana shall be legal for all patients with valid Medical Marijuana patient licenses to purchase Medical Marijuana from a legally licensed dispensary, to consume Medical Marijuana and Medical Marijuana products, and to cultivate Medical Marijuana.

The State of Oklahoma shall decriminalize Marijuana/Cannabis, Marijuana paraphernalia, marijuana infused products and marijuana concentrates, marijuana concentrate smoking devices immediately upon the passage of this Article.

Upon the passage of this Article the Oklahoma Department of Corrections shall, immediately release any and all offenders serving time for the following cannabis/marijuana-related offenses:

- a. Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance (Marijuana);**
- b. Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance (Marijuana) with the Intent to Distribute;**
- c. Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance (Marijuana) within 2,000 Feet of a School or Public Park;**
- d. Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance (Marijuana) in the Presence of a Minor Child;**
- e. Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance (Marijuana) without a Tax Stamp; and**
- f. Possession of Proceeds Derived from a Violation of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act, to wit any of the crimes listed in sections a through e herein.**

The State of Oklahoma shall, upon the release of all offenders, who committed the above crimes, from all state prisons, city, municipals, county township jails and detention centers, immediately start the expungement process, cost to the State of Oklahoma, for all persons released for the following crimes:

- a. Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance (Marijuana);**

- b. Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance (Marijuana) with the Intent to Distribute;
- c. Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance (Marijuana) within 2,000 Feet of a School or Public Park;
- d. Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance (Marijuana) in the Presence of a Minor Child;
- e. Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance (Marijuana) without a Tax Stamp; and
- f. Possession of Proceeds Derived from a Violation of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act, to wit any of the crimes listed in sections a through e herein.

The State of Oklahoma shall, expunge the records of all offenders, with cost to the State of Oklahoma, for all persons who have been convicted of and or charged for the following crimes:

- a. Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance (Marijuana);
- b. Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance (Marijuana) with the Intent to Distribute;
- c. Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance (Marijuana) within 2,000 Feet of a School or Public Park;
- d. Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance (Marijuana) in the Presence of a Minor Child;
- e. Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance (Marijuana) without a Tax Stamp; and
- f. Possession of Proceeds Derived from a Violation of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act, to wit any of the crimes listed in sections a through e herein.

This Article shall become effective immediately upon the passage of this Article.



BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF OKLAHOMA THAT A NEW ARTICLE 32 TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA BE APPROVED.

As per Article 31 of the Oklahoma State Constitution, Adult Use of marijuana shall be legal for persons eighteen (18) years of age and older to purchase from a legally licensed adult-use dispensary, to possess, and to consume marijuana and marijuana products.

As per Article 31 of the Oklahoma State Constitution and Oklahoma State Question 788, Medical Marijuana shall be legal for all patients with valid Medical Marijuana patient licenses to purchase Medical Marijuana from a legally licensed dispensary, to consume Medical Marijuana and Medical Marijuana products, and to cultivate Medical Marijuana.

The State of Oklahoma shall decriminalize Marijuana/Cannabis, Marijuana paraphernalia, marijuana infused products and marijuana concentrates, marijuana concentrate smoking devices immediately upon the passage of this Article.

Upon the passage of this Article the Oklahoma Department of Corrections shall, immediately release any and all offenders serving time for the following cannabis/marijuana-related offenses:

- a. Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance (Marijuana);
- b. Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance (Marijuana) with the Intent to Distribute;
- c. Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance (Marijuana) within 2,000 Feet of a School or Public Park;

The State of Oklahoma shall, upon the release of all offenders, who committed the above crimes, from all state prisons, city, municipals, county township jails and detention centers, immediately start the expungement process, cost to the State of Oklahoma, for all persons released for the following crimes:

- a. Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance (Marijuana);

- b. Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance (Marijuana) with the Intent to Distribute;
- c. Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance (Marijuana) within 2,000 Feet of a School or Public Park;
