

2009 Supplement to the Oklahoma Administrative Code now available!

The **2009 Supplement** to the **Oklahoma Administrative Code (OAC)** is now available. The **OAC** and its annual supplements comprise the only official compilation of Oklahoma's permanent rules and executive orders. The **2009 Supplement** directly supplements the **2006 Edition** of the **OAC** and supersedes the **2008 Supplement**. It contains updates issued since publication of the **2006 Edition** and filed with the Secretary of State's Office of Administrative Rules by August 15, 2009.

Full editions of the **OAC** are published every five years and, between publications of full editions, cumulative supplements are published annually. Between the annual **OAC** publications, the semi-monthly issues of *The Oklahoma Register* serve as supplementation to the **OAC**. **At any given point in time, therefore, current rules can be found by checking the latest full edition of the OAC, the latest annual supplement, and emergency, permanent, and preemptive rule updates promulgated in issues of the Register after the August 15 closing date for the last annual OAC publication (i.e., edition or annual supplement).**

Each annual publication of the **OAC** is available for purchase as a full set and by individual Title(s), as follows:

- Full sets** - Full set publications of each edition and each cumulative annual supplement are available in print and on cd. Each full set publication includes a comprehensive subject index of the rules and executive orders included in that year's publication. The **2009 Supplement** consists of nine printed volumes, and the **2006 Edition** consists of 21 printed volumes. *(See attached order form for 2009 Supplement and 2006 Edition prices. For other annual publications, contact the Office of Administrative Rules.)*
- Individual Titles** - Individual Title publications are available in print only. Titles are extracted from each year's annual publication and published individually. Each Title publication includes a detailed subject index for that Title. *(See attached order form for 2009 Supplement and 2006 Edition prices.)*

Are you also interested in subscribing to The Oklahoma Register? With the additional purchase of an annual subscription to the *Register*, you will always have access to the current official text of Oklahoma's rules and executive orders, including those that have been promulgated since publication of the last *Edition* or *Supplement*.

The *Register* is published semi-monthly. Each issue contains the text of recently-enacted emergency rules, preemptive rules, and executive orders, as well as the text of permanent rules that are scheduled to become effective after being published in the *Register*. The permanent rules, preemptive rules, and executive orders that are filed by August 15 for publication in the *Register* are then published at the end of the year in the annual **OAC** publication (edition or cumulative supplement). **However, emergency rules are NOT published in the OAC, so the Register is the only official source for tracking or researching Oklahoma's emergency rules.** The *Register* also contains various notices that will allow you to participate in the rulemaking process prior to adoption or enactment of a rule, and to track the progress of a proposed rule through the review/approval process.

The Oklahoma Register includes:

- notices of intended rulemaking (comment periods and public hearings)
- notices of continued or cancelled comment periods or public hearings
- notices that proposed rules have been adopted and submitted for gubernatorial and legislative review
- notices of gubernatorial approval/disapproval of rules
- notices of legislative disapproval of rules
- notices of withdrawn rules
- emergency and preemptive rules that have recently become effective (i.e., approved by the Governor)
- permanent rules that have recently become "finally adopted" (i.e., approved by both the Governor and the Legislature - or by joint resolution of the Legislature) and will become effective a minimum of 10 days after publication
- recently-issued executive orders
