I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, hereby direct that appropriate steps be taken to fly all American and Oklahoma flags on State property at half-staff from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 16, 2015, to honor former Representative David Dank, who passed away on Friday, April 10, 2015.

David Dank was elected to serve in the Oklahoma House of Representatives in 2007, and succeeded his wife, Odilia Dank, in representing the people of District 85. Often called "the conscience of the Legislature," Representative Dank demonstrated his commitment to advancing the interests of the average citizen by championing measures to benefit senior citizens and reform tax credits. This hard-working public leader and astute businessman will be fondly remembered, and sorely missed, by Oklahomans everywhere.

Twenty years after the Murrah Bombing, we remember the 168 lives lost and the hundreds injured on that terrible day. We offer our prayers and condolences to the families they left behind.

We also pledge our commitment to honoring and reviving the sense of community spirit that became known as the "Oklahoma Standard" in the days and weeks after April 19, 1995. The attack that was meant to weaken our community instead brought Oklahomans of all races, religions and walks of life together.
