THIRD AMENDED EXECUTIVE ORDER 2017-43

To the Honorable Members of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Honorable Members of the Oklahoma State Senate:

I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, pursuant to the authority vested in me by the provisions of Section 7 of Article VI of the Oklahoma Constitution, hereby amend the call for the Second Extraordinary Session of the Fifty Sixth Legislature which convened at the State Capitol on Monday, December 18, 2017. I recommend the following amended subjects for the Legislature's consideration:

To address the necessary additional budget cuts for FY18 and the implementation of this budget which are needed by virtue of the failure of HB 1033; and

To address additional supplemental funding for Graduate Medical Education.

Copies of this Third Amended Executive Order shall be distributed to every member of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, every member of the Oklahoma State Senate, the Clerk of the House of Representatives, the Secretary of the Senate, and the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

FOURTH AMENDED EXECUTIVE ORDER 2017-44

WHEREAS, the State of Oklahoma is experiencing cold weather after a period of unseasonably mild temperatures, which has resulted in increased demand for liquefied petroleum products, hereinafter referred to as "propane;" and

WHEREAS, distributors of liquefied petroleum products in the State of Oklahoma are experiencing challenges in the implementation of electronic logging devices; and

WHEREAS, the potential for cold weather temperatures, may result in increased demand for propane; and

WHEREAS, liquefied petroleum products resources at certain Oklahoma refineries are currently stressed, significantly delaying the delivery of liquefied petroleum products to transportation companies in some instances, thereby forcing transportation companies and retailers to obtain liquefied petroleum products from other locations in surrounding states; and

WHEREAS, many Oklahoman residents depend on the use of liquefied petroleum products for survival during the winter months; and

WHEREAS, the limited suspension of certain hours of service regulations for drivers of commercial motor vehicles transporting liquefied petroleum products in our state will ensure adequate supplies of liquefied petroleum products throughout the state, thereby reducing the damaging effects of a potential shortage; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Transportation Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration issued Regional Declaration of Emergency Under 49 CFR 390.23 on December 30, 2017, and extended the Declaration on January 10, 2018, January 24, 2018 and February 6, 2018, which remains in effect until 11:59 PM (ET), February 28, 2018 and includes the state of Oklahoma in its exemption from Parts 390 through 399 of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (FMCSRs);

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, pursuant to the power vested in me by Sections 1 and 2 of Article VI

Executive Orders

of the Oklahoma Constitution and 63 O.S. § 683.1 *et seq.*, and pursuant to Part 390.23 of Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations, hereby declare that because there is a state of emergency existing in the State of Oklahoma due to limited liquefied petroleum products supplies, it is necessary to assist and expedite all efforts of transportation of liquefied petroleum products throughout Oklahoma. In order to accommodate this need and to provide assistance to the citizens of Oklahoma in this extraordinary situation, I hereby order vehicles used in the support efforts to be exempt from Parts 390 through 399 of Title 49 of the Code of Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations.

Nothing contained in this declaration shall be construed as an exemption from the Controlled Substances and Alcohol Use and Testing requirements (49 C.F.R. Part 382), the Commercial Driver's License Standards requirements (49 C.F.R. Part 383), the Minimum Levels of Financial Responsibility for Motor Carrier requirements (49 C.F.R. Part 387), or any other portion of the regulations not specifically identified herein. Motor carriers that have an Out-Of-Service Order in effect cannot take advantage of the relief from regulation that this declaration provides.

While operating under this order, drivers of commercial motor vehicles shall be required to spend a minimum of 8 hours in sleeper berth within any given 24-hour period. The duration of each timeframe spent in sleeper berth within each 24-hour period shall be at the discretion of each driver based on his/her needs; as long as the sum of all said sleeper berth time totals a minimum of the required 8 hours.

This Order applies only to the transportation of liquefied petroleum products to provide direct assistance to this emergency. No other products, including other petroleum products, are covered by the exemption and suspension under this Order.

Copies of this Executive Order shall be distributed to the Director of Emergency Management who shall cause the provisions of this Order to be implemented by all appropriate agencies of state government.

This emergency notice will remain in effect until 11:59 PM (ET), February 28, 2018.

EXECUTIVE ORDER 2018-2

To the Honorable Members of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, the Honorable Members of the Oklahoma State Senate, all cabinet members, and all directors of state agencies:

WHEREAS, the Occupational Licensing Task Force issued a report containing recommendations in January 2018. One of the main findings of the Task Force is the lack of unified data available to policy makers and the public regarding occupational licensing.

WHEREAS, One of the recommendations from the report is to continue the work of the Task Force by maintaining a centralized database for occupational licensing and to require all agencies, boards and commissions to report information to the database.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, pursuant to the power and authority vested in me by Sections 1 and 2 of Article VI of the Oklahoma Constitution hereby direct as follows:

1. The Occupational Licensing Database created by the Task Force shall continue to provide a centralized point of information regarding occupational licenses in the State of Oklahoma including, but not limited to: type of licenses, number of licenses, fees associated with obtaining a license, training and renewal requirements for a license, and links to licensing websites.
2. I further direct all state agencies, boards and commissions to:
 - A. Identify all occupational licenses administered by your agency and all the requirements necessary to obtain the license;
 - B. Identify the schedule of fees for obtaining licenses administered by your agency, including fees to renew the license;
 - C. Identify and provide links to all necessary forms and other administrative requirements to obtain a license; and
 - D. Report all information to the Oklahoma Department of Labor by March 31, 2018.
3. The Oklahoma Department of Labor shall become the central coordinating entity for the reporting of occupational licensing information from all state agencies, boards and commissions.
4. The Chief Information Officer (CIO) within the Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall provide technological support to the Oklahoma Department of Labor for the Occupational Licensing database. The Occupational Licensing database shall be made available and accessible to the public on the internet.
5. The Oklahoma Department of Labor and the Chief Information Officer at the Office of Management and Enterprise

Services will execute an agreement for the administration and support for the licensing database.

6. The final approval of any new agency rule changes or fee changes by this Office shall be contingent on the agency complying with this Executive Order.

7. The Cabinet Secretaries shall assure enforcement of this Executive Order and fully cooperate with the CIO to enforce compliance with this Executive Order.

Copies of this Executive Order shall be distributed to the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services; and the cabinet secretaries to further distribute to directors of agencies.
